
Respiratory Virus PCR Statistics Ampath Countrywide February/March 2020



Respiratory virus multiplex PCR: March findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during March were Rhino/Enterovirus (28%), Rhinovirus (27%), Adenovirus (10%) and Parainfluenza virus (9%).
- RSV increased from 3% in February to 6% in March.
- Influenza A and B remained stable.
