

Respiratory virus multiplex PCR: March findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during March were Rhino/Enterovirus (39%) and Adenovirus (16%).
- RSV was circulating at 4% during March.
- Influenza A rates increased from 10% in February to 15% in March.
