

Respiratory Virus Multiplex PCR: January findings

- The most frequently detected viruses during January were Rhino/Enterovirus (31%), Rhinovirus (27%), and Adenovirus (8%).
- RSV was circulating at low levels during January (1%).
- The routine respiratory viral PCR tests offered by Ampath does not include testing for Severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) which has been confirmed as the causative virus of Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
