

RESPIRATORY VIRUS STATISTICS MAY/JUNE 2022

Comments

- Most frequently-detected viruses during June: Influenza A virus (30.1%), rhino/enterovirus (25.1%) and rhinovirus (16%).
- Where Influenza A typing results were available, 73% typed as H1N1 and 27% typed as H3N2.
- Analysis per epidemiological week for SARS-CoV-2, Influenza A and RSV:
 - Influenza A: rapid increase in the percentage positive specimens during May, peaking during the first week of June, with a subsequent decrease towards the last week of June/early July.
 - SARS-CoV-2 and RSV: during June, a further decrease in the percentage positive specimens was observed.
