Early screening with the TREC/KREC PCR is the best way to know whether your baby's immune system is working correctly.

A genetic condition may prevent newborn babies from fighting infection later on in life. These conditions are severe and life threatening.

Live vaccines, in the form of oral polio drops and BCG, are lifesaving and recommended for babies. However, they may cause disease in those with an abnormal immune system. You can vaccinate with greater confidence once you know that your baby does not have a severe immunodeficiency.
